About Ray's Drive Inn

Ray's Drive Inn first opened at the corner of SW 19th Street and Guadalupe Street in 1956, by Raymond "Ray" Lopez and later acquired by Ray's younger brother Arturo Lopez in 1982. After Arturo's passing in 2015, Ray's Drive Inn is now owned and operated by Arturo's wife, Gloria, son, John Louis and daughter, Maria Idalia "Lali." The Lopez's sons received their inspiration of owning a business from their parents, Louis and Basilia who opened a small fruit and grocery store in their home from 1926-1949 located at 1419 EI Paso Street, near Our Lady of Guadalupe Church. White Louis worked for the Southern Pacific Railroad, Basilia operated the grocery store. "My mother was the business woman of the Lopez family," Arturo recalled. Ray opened Ray's Drive Inn by featuring free movies to the neighborhood families and serving hamburgers 5 for \$1.00, delicious fried chicken, traditional fresh hand squeezed lemonade and ice cold beer. On the weekends, Ray featured live music by area bands including Tejano legend, Isidro Lopez "El Indio." Ray's Drive Inn quickly became a favorite eatery for many that live in the area, including many public figures, and military personnel. In 1966 Arturo, moved to Southern California with his wife, Gloria, and young son, John Louis. In 1977 Arturo opened "Arturo's Puffy Tacos" in La Habra, California and now located in Whittier, California. In May of 1982, Arturo agreed to purchase Ray's Drive Inn from his oldest brother, Ray. Ray had one stipulation and that was that the name of the restaurant would remain "Ray's Drive Inn" and with that Arturo commuted every two weeks from California to San Antonio, Texas to take care of his businesses. On November 3, 1992 Ray's Drive Inn received the official trademark for the "Puffy Taco" and has since been featured on cable food networks as "The Best of the Best in Mexican Food." Ray's Drive Inn has been recognized The Current, Conexión SA, La Prensa, and Texas Monthly. In 2013 News 4 Best of San Antonio awarded Ray's Drive Inn the "Best Puffy Tacos Aw
